ABORIGINAL ACKNOWLEDGMENT



ABOUT THE ROLE

As an experienced Senior Mechanical Maintenance Technician, the employee is responsible for delivery of both planned and reactive mechanical maintenance works across East Gippsland Water assets with an initial focus on water recycling treatment facilities. In addition to the delivery of mechanical maintenance, the employee will provide specialised input into:

- the development and optimisation of mechanical maintenance plans and schedules
- Project scoping and design relevant to staff's skills and knowledge
- Development of maintenance procedures and documentation
- Condition assessment reports

This role will initially focus on recycled water treatment plants within the East Gippsland Water network. As part of this initial focus the role will also provide general operational and maintenance support for recycled water treatment. However, it is expected that within 12 months the role will transition to central maintenance team with a mechanical maintenance focus across all assets.

WHAT YOU WILL BE DOING

Mechanical Maintenance	 Coordinate and deliver mechanical maintenance activities associated with recycled water treatment facilities Carry out repair works or coordinate contractors to deliver works if they are unable to be completed in-house. Provide expert guidance into the development and optimisation of mechanical maintenance schedules Assist in the coordination of major repairs. Carry out other projects as directed within skill level
Project Delivery / Assistance	 Assist with scoping and delivery of minor mechanical renewals projects. Coordination and supervision of contractors undertaking minor works, as appropriate.
Technical Support	 Production of maintenance reports including recommended repair or replacement options for mechanical equipment Complete condition assessments and provide recommendations for ongoing maintenance strategies to best ensure we meet our levels of service
Leadership	 Provide and pass on relevant knowledge, training and mentoring to team members and other employees where possible. Liaise effectively across other sections of EGW. Engage with people in intelligent and professional manner, conduct productive meetings, manage conflict constructively, and foster effective team building. Take the lead to analyse complex issues, identify root causes, implement effective solutions, and make informed decision.
Culture, Values & Behaviours	 Remain approachable and available for all staff within the team, promoting a positive, optimistic and enthusiastic work culture. Support in building a supportive and cooperative team environment, one that recognises the value of collaboration. Respect a workplace culture that enables diversity and fair inclusive practices.
